## Public Case Synopses

June 2015

	Outcome	Description
1	Sent to mediation, Dismissed – failure to cooperate	<b>5-104 Impartial Policing</b> Complainant states officers pulled up behind a group of young men sitting in a parked car and began to run the license plate number of the parked car. Complainant states officers were harassing the young men. Complainant states that they did it twice in the same day. Additionally, Complainant states that after he made his complaint officers came back around by his house three more times, and waved at him while he was outside playing football with his children.
2	Sent to investigation, Dismissed – failure to cooperate	<b>5-301 Use of Force</b> Complainant alleges he was a guest at a house when officers in squad [] arrived. Complainant alleges that he answered the door and officers asked if he lived in the home. Complainant responded that he did not but would find the owner. Complainant alleges that he attempted to shut the door, and an officer responded, "No, you can't close this door." Complainant alleges that the officer grabbed him with his left hand and threw him outside. Complainant alleges that he "upper cut [Complainant] with his right fist" and stated, "I will f*ck you up if you try anything you f*ck, are you resisting me?" Complainant alleges he responded, "No, I'm not resisting you, I don't live here," to which the officer responded by grabbing his hair and throwing him into the street, stating, "Get out of here you f*ck."
3	Sent to mediation, Dismissed – Failure to cooperate	<b>5-105(3) Professional Code of Conduct</b> Complainant states an officer did not help him, yelled at him, and told Complainant he was lying.
4	Sent to investigation, Dismissed – no jurisdiction	<b>No officer identified</b> Complainant alleges that he was leaving a bar downtown and was attempting to get to his car but was blocked by a mounted officer. Complainant alleges that when he was told to walk in the opposite direction from his car, he told the officer "but my car is right there." Complainant alleges that the officer yelled "go away" and maced him in the face "at point blank rage."
5	Sent to investigation, Dismissed – no basis	<b>5-105(2) Professional Code of Conduct</b> Complainant alleges that she was the victim of a robbery. Complainant alleges that the officers who responded did not take a report. Complainant alleges that when she followed up with the precinct, the officers she spoke with told her that they would not take a report from her in particular. There was a report taken, but Complainant alleges that no one would provide her with this information. Complainant alleges that officers responded to another call and "pull[ed] down [her] pants and put [her] in the car in cuff[s] for no reason and was name call[sic] [her]."
6	Sent to Investigation, Dismissed – No Basis	<b>5-105(14) Professional Code of Conduct</b> Complainant alleges a neighboring landlord drove on his property, hit him with his car, and then pinned him against the garage. Complainant alleges officers responded and did not talk to the Complainant, did not take a report, and one officer told the Complainant to shut his mouth.
7	Sent to coaching – officer coached with policy violation.	<b>7-401 Normal Vehicle Operation</b> Complainant states he saw squad [] driving aggressively. Complainant states he slowed down to get the squad to pass him and sped up to the speed limit. Complainant states he was pulled over and the officer had an unprofessional attitude.

8	Sent to coaching - Officer(s) coached, no policy violation	<p><b>5-105(10) Professional Code of Conduct</b>                  Complainant alleges he was at [a grocery store] and was approached by an officer. Complainant alleges he the officer told Complainant he was a "f*cking liar for saying he assaulted him last year, "would take Complainant's *ss to jail," and "get the "f*ck out of [his] store." Complainant stated the officer assaulted him and charged him with trespassing for an incident that occurred at the store one year prior.</p>
9	Dismissed – Failure to cooperate	<p><b>5-104 Impartial Policing</b>                  Complainant alleges that police were “disrespecting” him. Complainant alleges he was harassed by police because he was arrested for a robbery without probable cause.</p>
10	Sent to investigation, Dismissed – No basis	<p><b>5-104 Impartial Policing</b>                  Complainant alleges officers entered her apartment without papers or a search warrant to remove her son. Complainant alleges she asked officers to leave, and officers wouldn't. Complainant alleges officers grabbed her son, and as she was following them out, an officer pushed her back under her throat.</p>
