Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. Bomb detection security services for 2015 Vikings football games (15-01226)

Authorizing a revenue agreement for up to \$23,715 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police department to provide two Bomb Unit technicians and one Police Officer K-9 handler, for bomb detection security services for ten Vikings Football games at the TCF Stadium during the 2015 season.

On motion by Gordon, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved.

2. Bomb detection security services for 2015 Gopher football games (15-01227)

Authorizing a revenue agreement for up to \$18,972 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police Department to provide two Bomb Unit technicians and one Police Officer K-9 handler, for bomb detection security services for seven Gopher football games and one homecoming event at the TCF Stadium during the 2015 season.

3. Adult DWI Court in Hennepin County (15-01228)

Accepting a grant of \$10,980 from the Fourth Judicial Court in Hennepin for continuation of officer and clerical support of DWI Court for one year, beginning Oct. 1, 2015.

4. Minneapolis Police Conduct Oversight Commission's (PCOC) body camera report (15-01229)
