1. Joyce Foundation Grant ([15-00092](#)):

Authorizing acceptance of \$30,000 in grant funding from the Joyce Foundation to support the position of Community Engagement Coordinator and other project costs; Adopt resolution appropriating funds (Refer to W&M).

2. Target Foundation Grant ([15-00093](#)):
