Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. 2015 Urban Scholars request to receive funds ([15-00766](#))

Authorizing the Dept. of Civil Rights to accept program funds in the amount of \$27,753 from its Urban Scholar partner organizations (Minneapolis Public Schools, The Metropolitan Council, Greater Twin Cities United Way, PCL Construction, The Minneapolis Parks and Recreation Board, and the State of Minnesota) to cover professional services for Urban Scholars programming.

2. Mounted Patrol Horse Boarding Contract Amendment ([15-00767](#))

Authorizing amendment of contract with Horsemen, Inc. for the boarding of police mounted patrol horses, increasing by \$96,600 for one year and authorizing execution of any documents necessary to effectuate the agreement. Further, that the Purchasing Department be authorized to continue payments for services provided up to \$25,000 while this agreement is approved and executed Staff

3. Public Assistance Discrimination Ordinance ([15-00659](#))

Referring to staff the subject matter of an ordinance amending Title 7, Chapter 139 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Civil Rights: In General, prohibiting discrimination based on receipt of public assistance, including tenant-based Section 8 assistance, regardless of any requirements of such public assistance program.
