1. Educational partnership agreements ([15-00957](#))
 - a. Authorizing establishment of a partnership with Augsburg College so the City of Minneapolis can be a participating member of the Augsburg Partnership Grant.
 - b. Authorizing establishment of a partnership with Saint Mary's University of Minnesota so the City of Minneapolis can be part of their Collegiate Partnership Program.
 - c. Authorizing establishment of similar partnerships with local universities, colleges, and technical schools in the Twin City metropolitan area and greater Minnesota, as opportunities present themselves.
