1. Chapter 535 Regulations of General Applicability.
2. Chapter 536 Specific Development Standards.
3. Chapter 537 Accessory Uses and Structures.
4. Chapter 541 Off-Street Parking and Loading.
5. Chapter 546 Residence Districts.
6. Chapter 547 Office Residence Districts.
7. Chapter 548 Commercial Districts.
8. Chapter 549 Downtown Districts.
