The City of Minneapolis should oppose efforts to apply inverse condemnation claims to city solid waste contracting decisions or to allow automatic contractual damage claims for solid waste haulers that lose competitive bids in organized collection communities. Minneapolis should also support legislation that would clarify the process for establishing organized collection and make it clear that those cities already organized, that are seeking new competitive bids or requests for proposals, do not need to follow the same full process as those seeking to organize for the first time.
