**A. Text Amendment:** Application by Amending Title 20 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances as follows:

Amending Chapter 520 related to Zoning Code: *Introductory Provisions*

Amending Chapter 525 related to Zoning Code: *Administration and Enforcement*

Amending Chapter 543 related to Zoning Code: *On-Premise Signs*

Amending Chapter 544 related to Zoning Code: *Off-Premise Advertising Signs and Billboards*

Amending Title 22 and Title 23 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances as follows:

Amending Chapter 598 relating to Land Subdivision: *Land Subdivision Regulations*.

Amending Chapter 599 relating to Heritage Preservation: *Heritage Preservation Regulations*.

The purpose of the amendment is to change personnel titles to reflect the departmental reorganization.

**Action:** The City Planning Commission recommends that the City Council **approve** the zoning code text amendment, amending chapters 520, 525, 543, 544, as well as corresponding amendments to chapter 598 (Subdivision Regulations) and chapter 599 (Heritage Preservation Regulations).
