On July 25, 2010, Minneapolis Police took Mr. Mussa to the Juvenile Supervision Center for a curfew violation and for making a false police report. Mussa brought suit in United States District Court for false arrest, retaliation, and an equal protection violation. The parties have reached a proposed settlement of the matter for \$1,500.00 for all claims, including attorney fees. This office and the Minneapolis Police Department believe that this settlement is in the best interests of the City.
