They will only be offering delivery service Sunday-Thursday from 10:00a.m - 3:00a.m and Friday –Saturday, from 11:00p.m-3:00a.m.

Public Hearing Requirement: A public hearing is required for this license application. 43 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 300 feet of the premises on March 10, 2014. An electronic hearing notice was e-mailed to Council Member Andrew Johnson, the Nokomis East Neighborhood Association, and the Longfellow Business Association. The public hearing will be held on Tuesday, April 1, 2014, at the Community Development & Regulatory Services Committee meeting.

Background: The applicant proposes to extend the hours of operation for their food manufacturer license for delivery service until 3:00A.M., seven days a week. The Business will close to the public at 10pm weekdays and 11pm on weekends. This location has had a food manufacturer license for the past 22 years.

Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized:

The Third Precinct of the Minneapolis Police Department has discussed security issues with the applicant. Security cameras are installed on the exterior of the building which also allows the General Manager to view any outside activity of the restaurant. A silent alarm is installed on the front and back doors.

Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise:

Staff will remove litter twice daily.

Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.

The business is categorized as a food manufacturer which is a permitted use in the AP/C1 district.

History of complaints related to the use.

There are no significant police calls for service at this location for the past three years.

LICENSE CONDITIONS

There are no license conditions being placed on this license at this time.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division make the following recommendation:

Grant the license applicant the following Extended Hours license for delivers only until 3:00 a.m., seven days a week.

This is an annually reviewed license. These hours will be reviewed at the next license renewal period. It will be possible to restrict the hours further if there are violations related to the Extended Hours license.
