BUSINESS LICENSE OPERATING CONDITIONS

Re: L317-50023 SINNERS
for EXTENDED HOURS

1. The City of Minneapolis Bureau of Fire Prevention & Inspections Division has certified that the maximum occupant load for the establishment at 121 Washington Avenue North is 161. No more than 161 patrons shall be allowed inside the establishment at any given time. The licensee shall employ the use of a device(s) that will make an accurate occupancy count readily available for law enforcement, or other regulatory agents, upon request.
2. A queue line shall not be allowed to form on the public right of way.
3. Security personnel shall wear shirts that are clearly labeled "SECURITY".
4. The establishment shall use a wand along with a pat search for patrons entering and re-entering the establishment.
5. No new patrons shall be allowed to gain entrance to the establishment after 2:30 A.M. This policy shall be conspicuously posted.
6. Entertainers shall not perform lap dances or bed dances in areas other than areas designated on an approved diagram (to be submitted upon signing this agreement).

7. Before hiring, the licensee shall perform background checks on all entertainers and all other staff using this website <https://www.cch.state.mn.us/>.
8. The licensee shall utilize an electronic ID scanner to maintain a "Do Not Admit" list, which shall be made readily available upon request by Licenses & Consumer Services or the Police Department.
9. The licensee shall maintain increased lighting in working condition during operating hours.
10. Implement and continuously enforce a dress code for patrons to enter the establishment.
11. The licensee shall ensure that the back door (near the DJ booth) is not being accessed by patrons.

I have read and understand the conditions listed above. I agree with the conditions and understand that failure on our part or on the part of my company or employees to adhere to these conditions, may be cause for future adverse license action, including the suspension, revocation, or denial of the renewal of the L317-50023 SINNERS license. These conditions will be effective for the duration the license operates at these premises, unless otherwise amended by the City Council of Minneapolis.


