Background/Supporting Information Attached

The Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Title 10 Food Code, Chapter 188 – Administration and Licensing; and Title 14 Liquor and Beer, Chapter 364 – Liquor Regulations, and Chapter 368 – Beer Regulations contain language regarding toilet and restroom facilities that is redundant as it already exists in Minnesota Rules governing toilet and restroom facilities. The public hearing is set to authorize striking (deleting) the redundant language from the City Ordinances, and adding language indicating that in establishments where liquor or beer is sold, restroom facilities must comply with all requirements in applicable code, statute, rule or regulation.
