Subject: Request Permission for a Contract with Dakota County Technical College for a Driver Training Facility Rental

Recommendation: That the proper officials be authorized to execute a three-year contract agreement with the option for two one-year extensions, not to exceed \$250,500 for the first three years, for Emergency Response/Pursuit Training with Dakota County Technical College for a driver training facility rental.

Supporting Information

The Police Department currently trains sworn and non-sworn personnel in various aspects of driving. Sworn personnel are mandated by the MN State Legislature, MN POST Board (Peace Officer Standards and Training) to attend Emergency Response/Pursuit Training once every four years to retain their license. The Defensive Drive Training program also includes the Community Service Officers and Police Reserves.

The Minneapolis Police Department issued an RFP to lease a facility that provides the necessary accommodations where we can conduct the above training facility and Dakota County Technical College was selected. The contract term is for three years at \$83,500 per year on a per-use basis, not to exceed \$250,500 over three years, with the option for two one-year extensions.
