the 2015 National Forensic Sciences Improvement Program

Recommendation: That the Police Department be authorized to accept \$16,535 from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Office of Justice Programs and execute a contract with them for the 2015 National Forensic Sciences Improvement program. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2014 in the amount of \$16,535. The funds will operate through Federal grant fund, 01300-4003300-321010.

Previous Directives: The Police Department has been fortunate to receive four other state National Forensic Sciences Improvement program grant awards for Crime Lab since 2011 to support general expenses and upgrades as well as five federal Coverdell grants for specific project upgrades.
