Public Hearing Requirement: A public hearing is required for this license application. 24 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 300 feet of the premises, and e-mailed to the Hawthorne Neighborhood Association, and the West Broadway Business Area Coalition on February 3, 2015. The public hearing will be held on March 3, 2015, at the Community Development & Regulatory Services meeting.

Background: The applicant proposes to extend the hours of operation for their Food Restaurant for dining room service to 12:00 midnight Sunday Through Thursday, and to 2:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. The restaurant does not serve alcoholic beverages, nor does it provide entertainment.

Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized:

Pappy's has designed their space so that there is room for a queue line to be inside. If the queue line is so long that it stretches outside, they will have crowd control personnel watching it. They will utilize their staff to manage the crowds during their busiest times (Friday and Saturday nights) as well as any other time that it is needed. The 4th Police Precinct has discussed security issues with the applicant.

Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise:

Staff will remove litter twice daily. They will pick up litter more than twice a day if it becomes necessary.

Description of how the business will have people exit the establishment at closing time and during an emergency that requires all people to exit the establishment quickly:

Pappy's indicates that they will stop taking customer orders ten minutes before closing and will close at the prescribed 12:00 midnight Sunday through Thursday, and 2:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday. All employees will finish cleaning and be out of premises by 3:00 a.m.

Such other reasonable and pertinent information as the city council may require:

Upon request, the licensee shall meet representatives of the City of Minneapolis to discuss any safety, security or operational concerns.

Proximity to permitted or conditional residential uses.

Nature of the business and its impacts of noise, light and traffic.

This restaurant is not adjacent to residential uses.

Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.

The business is categorized as a food restaurant which is a permitted use in the I1/PO district.

History of complaints related to the use.

There are no significant police calls for service at this location.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division make the following recommendation:

Business Licenses staff recommends the application for an Extended Hours license for Pappy's be approved. The applicant has completed a Security Plan Review with MPD 4th Precinct.
