A public hearing is scheduled for April 7th, as required by HUD, to provide the public an opportunity to verbally comment to the City on the proposed 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan.

A 30 day public comment period is set for March 17, 2015 through April 16, 2015 for written comments to be received. The 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan is the City's application to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the entitlement programs of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).

This year will be the first year of the Consolidated Plan 2015-2019 Five-Year Strategy.
