Subject: Contract For Downtown Improvement District Increased Summer Enforcement

Recommendation: That the Police Department be approved to enter into a contract agreement with the Downtown Improvement District to receive funds for police officer support of the Downtown Summer Community Engagement Pilot and for the authorized city officials to sign the contract agreement. The Department requests an increase to the general appropriation for 2015 by \$28,730. The contract will operate through the Police Special Revenue Fund 01210-4004100-345501.

Previous Directives: The Downtown Improvement District provided similar funds for an enhanced Police presence in 2014.
