

**Supporting Information**

On June 14, 2012, Plaintiff Marco Minarcaja and Defendant City employee Scott Bagley collided at the intersection of Johnson Street NE and Hennepin Avenue. Bagley's truck struck Plaintiff's vehicle on the passenger's door. Plaintiff claims Bagley negligently entered the intersection on a red light. Plaintiff claims property damage and physical injuries to his neck and back. The parties have negotiated a global settlement in which the City will pay \$11,000 to Plaintiff. Public Works administration approves of the settlement. We believe that the proposed settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend approval by this Committee and the City Council.
