PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant seeks to amend their Business License Operating Conditions.

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS: Notice is not required.

HISTORY OF CONDITIONS

Robert Anderson, General Manager, and Daniel Mays, Beer Manager, part owners of Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits located at 2315 18th Avenue Northeast, signed business license operating conditions on March 26, 2012 arising out of their new application for an off-sale liquor establishment in which the neighborhood had concerns and requested conditions be placed on their license.

CURRENT STATE OF BUSINESS

Since the beginning of operation in 2012 the business has been inspected randomly and on an annual basis for compliance with the business license operating conditions and no violations have been documented or reported to business licensing.

Mr. Anderson requested in writing that the following conditions be removed from his business license:

1. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall not allow sales of alcoholic beverages in containers of 100 milliliters or less;
2. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall not allow sales of individual containers of alcoholic beverages less than \$3.00; and
3. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall only be open to the public from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM, Monday through Thursday, and from 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM Friday and Saturday.

Mr. Anderson and his business partners feel they have operated in a responsible manner and been a positive partner in the neighborhood and surrounding community and that the continuation of these license conditions would continue to put them at a competitive disadvantage in competing with surrounding business.

Business Licensing staff checked with Minneapolis Police personnel and the Windom Park Citizens in Action Neighborhood group to determine if there were any objections to removing any of the requested conditions. There were no objections. Mr. Anderson signed a new business license operating conditions agreement with the changes noted above.

BUSINESS LICENSE OPERATING CONDITIONS

Re: L171 50021 STINSON WINE & SPIRITS
for LIQ OFF-SALE SERIES 2000

1. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall not allow sales of alcoholic beverages in growlers, or refilling of growlers.
2. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall not allow sales of 40 ounce beers.
3. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall not allow sales of lottery tickets.
4. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits will submit a final merchandising plan to Planning Staff for review and approval. No shelving, signage, merchandise, newspaper racks or other mechanisms shall be placed in front of the required ground level transparent windows.
5. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall comply with the specific development standards for a liquor store, off-sale, as defined by Chapter 536.20 of the Zoning Code.
6. Stinson Wine, Beer & Spirits shall comply with the window sign provisions as stated in Chapter 543.480 of the Zoning Code.
7. Final inspection and compliance with all provisions of applicable codes and ordinances.

I have read the conditions listed above. I agree with the conditions and understand that failure on our part or on the part of my company or employees to adhere to these conditions, may be cause for future adverse license action, including the suspension, revocation, or denial of the renewal of the L171 50021 STINSON WINE & SPIRITS license. These conditions will be effective for the duration the license operates at these premises, unless otherwise amended by the City Council of Minneapolis.
