Contract amendment with A+ Systems, Inc.

Description:

Authorizing an extension of Contract No. C-37156 with A+ Systems, Inc. for one (1) additional year, through August 31, 2016 and updating Terms and Conditions to reflect current standards.

Previous Actions:

May, 19, 2014 - Proper City Officials extended the contract C-37156 for one additional year, through August 31, 2015, and increased the contract by \$100,000 for a new-not-to exceed amount of \$150,000 over the life of the contract. The Terms and Conditions were updated to reflect the current standards.

Background/Analysis:

The City has a Professional Services Agreement, Contract C-37156, with A+ Systems to provide power and DSL (Digital Subscriber Line) connectivity to the safety cameras in the area around the Third and Fourth Police Precincts. The Minneapolis Police Department is the user of this contract which will expire August 31, 2014. The total contract value is \$50,000 and out of funds; therefore future payments cannot be made.

Information Technology (IT) is in the process of converting the DSL lines connected to the safety cameras in these areas to make use of the WiFi technology provided by USIW. After the conversion is complete, only one DSL line will be necessary in each of the precincts. The safety cameras in the Third Precinct area have been converted to WiFi. The conversion of the safety cameras in the Fourth Precinct is underway. No additional appropriation is required at this time.

Information Technology requests proper City officials to

- a) Extend contract, C-37156 with A+ Systems, Inc., for one (1) additional year, through August 31, 2016
- b) Update Terms and Conditions to reflect current standards
