The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

Charge Description: That on or about September 12, 2015, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, DETROIT DAVIS-RILEY possessed ammunition or a firearm and DETROIT DAVIS-RILEY has been convicted or adjudicated delinquent in this state or elsewhere of a crime of violence, Aggravated Robbery in the First Degree on May 7, 2012, for which the sentence or court supervision expired on or after August 1, 1993.

Minimum Sentence: 5 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On September 12, 2015, at approximately 2:30 a.m., Minneapolis Police mounted patrol and bike patrol were Downtown, monitoring and managing bar close. At least nine fully-uniformed officers, some on bicycles, and others on horses, were concentrated in the intersection of 5th Street and Hennepin Avenue, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. These officers are fully identified in police reports, and are referenced herein as Police Victims 1-9. Officers heard a loud, rapid succession of gunshots. Officers differentiated the sounds of multiple guns, with different calibers. The gunfire was coming directly toward the officers. Officers reported hearing the sounds of bullets whizzing by their heads. Mounted officers observed the sound of "pinging" as bullet rounds hit the light rail tracks in very close proximity to the horses. The officers believed that they were being fired upon and feared for their lives.

As the shots were fired, multiple officers observed an individual wearing a red sweatshirt on 5th street, about mid-block, firing a handgun toward the intersection. The individual with the red-sweatshirt was quickly apprehended and identified as MAURICE CARTER. Officers observed CARTER shoot multiple rounds from a semi-automatic handgun, and then calmly turn and walk away from the area. Officers quickly apprehended CARTER, and recovered a loaded handgun in his waistband. Video surveillance shows CARTER firing the handgun multiple times and within moments, his apprehension.

Other officers observed a second individual, later identified as DETROIT DAVIS-RILEY, Defendant herein, holding a handgun. DAVIS-RILEY was on the sidewalk south of the transit parking lot barrier fence. DAVIS-RILEY fled into a nearby alley. Officers apprehended DAVIS-RILEY in the alley. Officers recovered a firearm in DAVIS-RILEY's flight path. The firearm was on the ground, along with a cell phone and pair of headphones. Video surveillance shows DAVIS-RILEY firing a handgun multiple times in a southerly direction, toward the intersection, and then fleeing into the alley.

When the shots stopped, officers controlled a chaotic situation. There were at least 50 individuals on the sidewalk, on the light rail station, and in the streets. Officers located six individuals who had suffered gunshot injuries. Some of the injured had multiple gunshot injuries. Officers and first responders provided emergency medical care to the wounded. The shooting victims were transported to the hospital via ambulance, for treatment of the injuries.

Forensic scientists responded to the scene and recovered firearms evidence, including 27 discharged cartridge casings, from at least two different caliber weapons. Many of the discharged cartridge casings are the same caliber as the two firearms recovered from CARTER and near DAVIS-RILEY. Many of the casings were located in the area where CARTER was observed firing, and where video surveillance shows DAVIS-RILEY firing.

In a post-Miranda interview, DAVIS-RILEY admitted that he was involved in a verbal altercation with rivals, but denied firing a gun. DAVIS-RILEY admitted that his cell phone and headphones were missing. DAVIS-RILEY provided a description of the cell phone case, which matched the cell phone case found near the recovered firearm in the alley.

Investigators continue to review extensive video surveillance from the area, and have identified a third gunman. Investigators continue their investigation regarding the civilian witnesses who were hit by gunfire. Many of the victims stated that they were on the sidewalk, mid-block of 5th street, when they were hit by gunfire. All denied that they had seen the person or people that had fired upon them. Some were uncooperative at the scene, and remain uncooperative.

On May 7, 2012, DAVIS-RILEY was convicted of Aggravated Robbery in the First Degree, a felony crime of violence. DAVIS-RILEY is thus prohibited from possessing a firearm.
