Central Corridor LRT Project: Subordinate Funding Agreement 27 with the Metropolitan Council

Description:

Authorizing Subordinate Funding Agreement 27 whereby the Metropolitan Council will reimburse the City of Minneapolis up to \$5,700 for the installation of a variable message sign on Washington Avenue between Oak Street and Walnut Street.

Previous Actions:

March 24, 2015: Authorized proper City Officials to execute Subordinate Funding Agreement 26 with the Metropolitan Council.

Background/Analysis:

The Central Corridor Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project has constructed an 11-mile LRT line between Minneapolis and St Paul, now known as the Green Line. The Green Line is open to revenue service.

Construction of the Central Corridor LRT requires coordination of certain activities and materials between the Metropolitan Council and the City of Minneapolis. The Master Funding Agreement (MFA) between the Metropolitan Council and the City outlines a process to enter into subordinate funding agreements to account for costs associated with these activities.

Subordinate Funding Agreement (SFA) 27 provides for the Metropolitan Council to reimburse the City an amount not to exceed \$5,700 for staff time, material and equipment costs incurred by the City for installation of a variable message sign on Washington Avenue between Oak Street and Walnut Street.

Public Works requests authorization for the proper City officials to execute SFA 27 with the Metropolitan Council.
