Working Families ordinance.

Description:

Previous Actions:

In April 2015, the Minneapolis City Council passed a *Supporting a Strong Economy and Working Families* resolution which directed staff to, among other things: Develop policy proposals for Council consideration, including subject matter and proposed ordinance language, for earned safe and sick, fair scheduling, and wage theft prevention in the City of Minneapolis; tasks for the workgroup shall include design of a robust stakeholder engagement process that includes workers, businesses, and other interested and affected parties.
