Subject:

Bomb security services for Timberwolves basketball games during the 2015-2016 season at the Target Center.

Description:

Authorize the execution of a revenue contract to provide an estimated 2 (two) technicians and 1 (one) USPCA certified police canine from the City's Police Department at the rate of \$93 per hour, who will perform surveys of the Minneapolis Target Center to determine if bombs or explosives are present during Timberwolves basketball games for the 2015-16 season.

Previous Actions:

The MPD began providing security services to the Timberwolves since the second half of the 2013-2014 season.

Background/Analysis:

The revenue is estimated to be at \$50,220 and was anticipated in the 2016 Police Department budget so there is no financial impact
