**Background/Analysis:**

Enterprise Land Management System (ELMS) is new system of multiple technologies brought together for enterprise collaboration of the Regulatory Services Department, Community Planning & Economic Development, Health Department, and Public Works Department. It will replace KIVA (City's permitting, licensing, and inspections system), Digital Health (City's health inspections system) and other systems that are unsupported, outdated, lack efficiencies and automation.

ELMS will be integrated with other City systems improving interagency collaboration and data sharing capabilities. Data that formerly appeared in only one place at a time will now be simultaneously available to all staff needing the information.

System go-live is scheduled for October 3, 2016.
