Description:
Approving appointments of members to the Workplace Regulations Partnership.

Previous Actions:
At its regular meeting on October 23, 2015, City Council established the Workplace Regulations Partnership as an *ad hoc* working group charged with studying the impact of workplace regulations related to earned sick time and paid time off, including regional and cross-jurisdictional implications of such issues, and to submit recommendations related to potential policy proposals for earned sick time and paid time off to the Mayor and City Council by no later than February 24, 2016 [Legislative File No. 15-01373].

Background/Analysis:
The Workplace Regulations Partnership is to be a consortium of key stakeholders working to develop recommended policy options related to earned sick time and paid time off applicable within the City of Minneapolis. The Partnership is to be composed of 15 members representing the following four specific stakeholder groups:

- (1) Employees, especially low-wage earners;
- (2) Organized labor associations;
- (3) Employers, including large and small businesses and immigrant-owned businesses; and
- (4) Business groups and associations.

Nominations and/or applications were accepted through close of business November 9, 2015. The Clerk's Office has compiled a full roster of all applications submitted, copies of which were delivered to the Mayor and Council Members on Tuesday, November 10, 2015. The Mayor will appoint 3 members; the Council President will appoint 2 members; and the remaining 10 members will be appointed by the City Council.
