Denial of the Massage and Bodywork Establishment License Application – Kim Yi’s at 507 East Lake Street

Description:

An application for a Massage and Bodywork Establishment license was made by Kim Yi’s, LLC on July 8, 2014. The business was issued a citation for violating the unlawful acts section of MCO 286.100 (2)(3)(4) on November 4, 2014. This citation was upheld by an administrative hearing officer. The licensee was sent notice of intent to deny license on March 12, 2015. The licensee requested a hearing. That hearing was conducted on June 16, 2015. The administrative hearing officer made the findings of fact and conclusion of law recommending denial of license.

Previous Actions:

The City Council, on December 6, 2013, adopted the ordinance that required a license for massage and bodywork establishments. On the same date, the City Council adopted a work plan for the Minneapolis Coordinating Committee to Prevent Juvenile Sex Trafficking.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends adoption of the hearing officer’s findings and conclusions and denial of the license application.
