**Subject:**  
Community Action Agency hearing examiner appointment

**Description:**  
Approve appointment of Chief Administrative Law Judge Tammy Pust as presiding officer for the required public hearing regarding designation of a community action agency for the City of Minneapolis.

**Previous Actions:**  
December 2015: Council approved Resolution 15-01445 authorizing city staff to file a notice to designate a successor community action agency and retain a presiding officer for the required public hearing.

**Ward/Address:** All City wards.

**Background/Analysis:**  
To comply with the state rules governing the conduct of the public hearing for designation of a community action agency, council is required to appoint a presiding officer for the public hearing. The public hearing will be held on January 27, 2016, at 6 PM in Pohlad Hall at the Minneapolis Central Library. Staff has secured Chief Administrative Law Judge Tammy Pust to serve as presiding officer. Chief Judge Pust presided over the termination proceedings related to Community Action of Minneapolis and is very familiar with the rules regarding community action agencies.
