Authorizing proper City officials to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Labor Summer Jobs and Beyond: Career Pathways for Youth grant (CFDA #17.280)

Background/Analysis:

City of Minneapolis will partner with AchieveMpls and Minneapolis Public Schools to expand existing summer youth employment programs by coordinating employment and work experiences throughout the 12-month calendar year.

Eligible participants will be in-school and out-of-school youth between the ages of 16-24 years old, with limited or no work experience living in high-poverty zip codes. The intent of the program will be to provide assistance to youth to obtain summer jobs and/or year-round employment and other work experience opportunities that can facilitate their entry into career pathways.

The requested total federal award will be approximately \$2 million over the 24 month project period. No cost sharing or matching funds are required to apply for the grant, and none will be proposed.
