Mississippi Watershed Management Organization grant for East 24th Street and Snelling Avenue paving project.

Description:

Authorizing the extension of a termination date of a grant agreement with the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization from December 31, 2015 to December 31, 2016.

Previous Actions:

January 25, 2013 – Accepted \$1,100,000 LCDA grant funds for street improvements.

January 30, 2015 – Approve the construction and assessments for the street paving and abandon the street lighting for E 24th St and Snelling Ave paving project.

September 25, 2015 – Authorizing an agreement whereby the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization granting \$100,000 for increased storm water facilities for the E 24th St and Snelling Ave paving project.

September 25, 2015 – Increasing appropriation in CPV110PV by \$100,000 and increasing revenue source 322502 by \$100,000.

Background/Analysis:

The E 24th St and Snelling Ave paving project was delayed due to underground utility work in the project area. It is a joint project with CPED and Public Works that was initiated to support the development in this area of the city. CPED staff submitted a grant application to the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization to support the innovative storm water management system upgrade included within this project.
