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**Subject:**

Cooperative Agreement with the Minnesota Ballpark Authority (MBA) providing that the MBA will pay for pedestrian lighting as part of the City re-construction of 6th Avenue North from 5th Street to 200 feet north of Washington Avenue (Street Lighting Project No 6699L).

**Description:**

1. Authorizing the proper City officials to execute the proposed Cooperative Agreement with the Minnesota Ballpark Authority (MBA) providing that the MBA will pay for pedestrian lighting as part of the City re-construction of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to 200 feet north of Washington Avenue (Street Lighting Project No 6699L).
2. Amend Capital Budget resolution 2015R-497 by increasing the capital appropriation and revenue source 322502 in 04100-9010943, project CPV019 by \$250,000.

**Previous Actions:**

February 13<sup>th</sup> 2016 – City Council Resolution 2016R-051 ordering the work to proceed and adopting special assessments in the amount of \$302,913.95 for the project and reducing the current assessment appropriation from \$625,000 to \$302,915, requesting the Board of Estimate and Taxation to authorize the City's issuance and sale of assessment bonds in the amount of \$302,915 for the project , and ordering the abandonment and removal of areaways located in the public right-of-way in conflict with the project.

December 11<sup>th</sup> 2015 – City Council Resolution 2015R-509 designating the 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Paving Project, adopting the report receiving the cost estimate and list of benefited properties, directing the City Engineer to prepare the proposed the Street Construction Special Improvement Assessment; and scheduling the public hearing to consider approving the project, abandonment and removal of areaways, and consider the amount proposed to be assessed to each benefited property.

October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015 – City Council Resolution 2015R-431 directing the City Engineer to proceed with a formal request for a variance from MnDOT State Aid for the vertical profile on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North from 5<sup>th</sup> Street North to Washington Avenue North.

July 24<sup>th</sup> 2015 – City Council Resolution 2015R-304 directing the City Engineer to install parking restrictions on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Washington Avenue.

March 20, 2015 – Council adoption of T&PW report approving the project layout and authorizing negotiation with private property owners to acquire and execute easements and additional right-of-way if necessary.

**Background/Analysis:**


The City will be re-constructing 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to a point 200 feet north of Washington Avenue. The Minnesota Ballpark Authority would like pedestrian lighting along this section. Pursuant to Resolution 15-MBA-116, the MBA Board of Commissioners has provided formal direction to the MBA staff to provide funding for pedestrian lighting to the City for the City to perform or cause the performance of installation of the pedestrian lighting and the furnishing and installation of all conduits, lighting cabinets, wiring, power supply and reinforced concrete pole bases in an amount not to exceed \$250,000. There will be no special assessment of neighboring property owners for the pedestrian lighting.
