

## Public hearing to be held on City's recommended Community Action Agency designee

A public hearing regarding the recommended designation of the Community Action Partnership of Suburban Hennepin as the Community Action Agency for the City of Minneapolis will be held:

The hearing will be presided by Chief Judge Tammy Pust, Minnesota Office of Administrative Hearings. At the hearing, representatives of Community Action Partnership of Suburban Hennepin and the City of Minneapolis will discuss the designated agency's qualifications, expertise and experience in providing community action services to low-income people. Anyone interested can speak at the hearing. Written comments can also be submitted for up to twenty days after the hearing to the Office of Administrative Hearings' e-Comments website. The Community Action program was established in 1964 by federal law. The program's purpose is to assist low-income individuals and families to acquire useful skills and knowledge to become economically self-sufficient. Community Action Agencies are responsible to implement the program and must comply with federal and state guidelines. The Minnesota Department of Human Services is the designated state agency to oversee the program in Minnesota.
