Alcohol Server Training:

Alcohol server training will be conducted by Bob Pomplum of Loss Control Services & Serving Alcohol, Inc. Mr. Pomplum will present a course to all employees serving alcohol focusing on the basic TIPS training with emphasis on I.D. recognition. The course covers alcohol awareness, server responsibilities, carding, intervention, and Minnesota Alcohol Laws. Employees will be required to check I.D.'s of all patrons ordering alcohol who appear to be under 30 years of age. Employees who fail to comply will be reminded of their policy and retrained. If there are subsequent violations the employee will be terminated. Self-audits will be conducted by management, utilizing an improvement plan for failures.

Applicant

The applicant is Don Chilo Restaurant, Inc., a Minnesota company formed on March 25, 2005. They are registered under chapter 302A, File #1286316-2 of the Minnesota statutes. The applicant has provided documentation showing adequate, legal, and traceable funding for this venture. They have the required stock restriction on the transfer of shares and have the following shareholders and officers:

Manager

The owner, Pedro Fuentes-Clavel will be the manager of the business. He has many years of experience in the hospitality industry. He operates Taqueria El Chilo at the current address with a food restaurant license. He has in operation there since April of 2016. He also operates Don Chilo Restaurant at 417 East Lake Street, and has been there since 2005.

Premises

The premises will be located at 311-313 East Lake Street. It is a two-story building. The business will operate in 1,990 square feet of space on the first floor. They will have 32 indoor seats for patrons with no bar or service counter area.

Business Plan/Operations

Pedro Fuentes-Clavel has been operating a restaurant business since 2005. He now wants to offer wine and beer to his customers at Taqueria El Chilo #3 to complement their dining experience. The menu will include authentic Mexican food, including burritos, tortas, tacos, soups. The hours of operation will be 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Sunday to Thursday, and 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday. Staff will receive proper alcohol server training and will check for proper identification from all customers who wish to consume alcohol beverages. Problematic patrons will be dealt with immediately. All suspicious activity will be reported to the police immediately.

Public Hearing Summary

A public hearing for this license application will be held on May 3, 2016, in City Council chambers, Room 317, 350 S. 5th Street. On April 21, 2016, 220 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 600 feet of the premises. An electronic hearing notice was e-mailed to Council Member Alondra Cano, The Central Area Neighborhood Development Organization, and the Lake Street Council.

Police review


The Minneapolis Police Licensing Division has reviewed the applicant's financial and criminal history. They have determined the application meets the necessary requirements.
