Subject:

Revenue contract with the Minnesota Timberwolves for bomb detection at Target Center for up to fifty five (55) large scale events.

Description:

Authorizing a revenue agreement for approximately \$48,000 with the Minnesota Timberwolves for the City of Minneapolis Police department to provide two (2) Bomb Unit technicians and one (1) Police Officer K-9 handler, for bomb detection security services at Target Center for up to fifty five (55) large scale events.

Previous Actions:

The MPD began providing security services to the Timberwolves since the second half of the 2013-2014 season.

Council approved the 2013-2014 revenue agreement on March 7, 2014 and the 2014-2015 revenue agreement on October 3, 2014 (no file numbers found).

Background/Analysis:

The Police Department will provide up to two (2) Bomb Unit technicians and up to one (1) Police Officer K-9 handler, compensated at \$96 per hour per officer for up to three (3) hours per event for approximately \$48,000

Financial Review:

No additional appropriation required, amount included in current budget.
