Background/Analysis:

The EMS Pathways Academy is a partnership between the Minneapolis Fire Department, the Minneapolis Foundation, Hennepin County Medical Center Foundation and other healthcare organizations. This program targets Minneapolis residents with traditional barriers to employment, between the ages of 18-30 and provides them a paid internship in Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training and certification. The goal is to provide a pipeline of diverse candidates for the Minneapolis Fire Department and the emergency medical workforce of our community.
