Dear President Johnson & Council Members:

On behalf of the Minneapolis Charter Commission, I am writing to transmit a petition proposing to amend the Minneapolis City Charter that was submitted by the Committee for Professional Policing, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 410.12, subdivisions 1 and 2. That amendment seeks to require Minneapolis police officers to provide proof of professional liability insurance coverage throughout their terms of employment with the City.

In this regard, the Charter Commission plays a ministerial role: it is our duty to receive the petition and to transmit it to the City Council. At a special meeting conducted this date, the Charter Commission, on a motion duly made, seconded, and carried, did act to receive the petition submitted by the Committee for Professional Policing and transmitted that petition to the City Clerk, who accepted it on behalf of the City of Minneapolis. We understand the City Clerk has 10 days to validate the petition, after which, if the petition is found to be valid, it will be formally presented to the City Council for its consideration and further action.
