Subject:

Grant from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to prevent teen dating violence and youth violence

Description:

1. Accepting an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000 over five years from the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to prevent teen dating and youth violence.
2. Passage of resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Health Department.

Background/Analysis:

The department has been awarded a five year grant from CDC, Preventing Teen Dating and Youth Violence by Addressing Shared Risk and Protective Factors. The project focuses on implementing community-based prevention strategies, including a curriculum to be used with high school athletic teams and street and community outreach in north Minneapolis. Partners include the Youth Coordinating Board, Minneapolis Public Schools, and community agencies. The activities align with the Minneapolis Blueprint for Action to Prevent Youth Violence.

Financial Review:

Action requires an appropriation increase to the operating budget of \$1,700,000 in fund/department 01300-8600111 (revenue code 321007) and the 2016 appropriation in fund/department 01300-8600111 by \$1,700,000.
