Subject:

Authorization of Cooperative Agreement with Hennepin County for West Broadway Ave (Penn Ave N to 4th St N) and East Franklin Ave (Lyndale Ave S to 13th Ave S) Crosswalks

Description:

1. Authorizing Hennepin County agreements PW 58-20-12 and PW 59-20-12 for pedestrian improvements on Franklin Avenue East and West Broadway Avenue.
2. Accepting awards for \$27,420 and \$48,840 from Hennepin County covering 25% of construction costs for the Franklin Ave East and West Broadway Ave pedestrian projects.
3. Passage of Resolution increasing the appropriation and revenue source for the Hennepin County grants in the amount of \$76,260.

Previous Actions:

August 5, 2014 – Amend the 2014 Adopted Capital Budget 2013R-573 to establish CBIK27.

October 23, 2012 – Authorize Public Works staff to submit grant applications to Hennepin County grant funds for four bicycle and pedestrian projects.

Background/Analysis:

In 2013, Hennepin County awarded grant funding to two pedestrian projects on West Broadway Avenue (Penn Ave N to 4th St N) and Franklin Avenue (Lyndale Ave S to 13th Ave S). These projects consisted of durable crosswalk markings at multiple intersections along the identified segments. The County award is for 25% participation in the construction costs associated with these projects. The County's participation in the Franklin Avenue project was not to exceed \$48,840 while their participation in the West Broadway Avenue project was not to exceed \$27,420. This action is reimbursement for installation of the crosswalk improvements completed in July 2016. The County grant funding is set to expire December 31, 2016.
