- I.** I have been assigned to the following committees: Health, Energy and the Environment (HEE) as Vice Chair; Public Safety and Regulatory Services (PS&RS); Community Development (CD); Zoning and Planning (Z&P); Claims; Elections; Taxes; and Rules. I will serve on the Executive Committee as the minority caucus member. I have been appointed to the Central Corridor Coordinating Committee and the Joint City County Lead Task Force.

- IV.** Minnesota Students Association President Emily Serafy Cox has proposed a Student Rental Housing Summit.
