The department is requesting authorization to amend a lease agreement with Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS) related to the School Based Clinic (SBC) Program. The SBC program will continue to maintain services in six MPS locations, but is switching the services at Broadway School to Southwest High School. Broadway School is moving in the fall of 2010 to the North High School Building and will have its students use the North High School Based Clinic operated by the Hennepin County NorthPoint Health & Wellness Center. Southwest High School previously had a SBC provided through Teenage Medical Services, but that service was discontinued two years ago for budgetary reasons. The space is provided to the SBC program at no cost as part of a long standing partnership with MPS.
