The Minneapolis Civilian Police Review Authority (CRA) was created in 1990 for the purpose of investigating allegations of misconduct on the part of officers of the Minneapolis Police Department and making findings of fact, and conclusions based upon those findings of fact.

By ordinance, the CRA shall be comprised of eleven (11) members, six (6) of whom shall be appointed by the city council, and five (5) of whom shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to the approval of a majority of the city council. The members shall serve for terms of four

(4) years Currently there is one vacancy on the CRA. This action is a request to fill this vacancy.
