**Subject Permission to Enter into Contract Amendment**

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests permission to enter into a contract agreement with CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center and enter into a multi-year contract for forensic interview services for child and vulnerable adult victims of crime. The contract amount for 2006 is approximately \$119,855. Funding will be made from the Police General Fund 0100-400.

### Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to accept a response to our Request for Proposal from CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center for forensic interview services when necessary to interview children and vulnerable adults who are victims of crime. The MPD has reviewed the proposal from CornerHouse and it meets the needs of the department. The MPD will request assistance from the City Attorney's Office for development of the contract. The MPD proposes a three-year contract with CornerHouse for services. The contract amount for 2006 is approximately \$117,855, with moderate increases in 2007 and 2008.
