



Background/Supporting Information

The 2nd Avenue South tunnel was constructed in 1939 and is part of the larger Central City tunnel system. The Central City system is 3.9 miles and drains stormwater for the majority of the downtown area.

Recent large rain events in June and August damaged the 2nd Avenue South tunnel. The tunnel is in need of immediate repairs. Two sections of the tunnel liner have been compromised and are allowing clear water into a parallel sanitary tunnel. The project will repair the damaged sections and allow for some additional preventative maintenance work to be completed.

Funding for the project is 2009R-092 (07300-9010932-SW905) Combined Sewer Overflow Improvements and 2009R-587 (07300-9010932-SW011) Storm Drains & Tunnel Rehabilitation Program.


