RESOLUTION

Resolution of Appreciation for Phillip Koski for his dedicated service to the Heritage Preservation Commission:

Whereas, the Minneapolis Heritage Preservation Commission is the quasi judicial citizen review panel that provides direction and regulation on preservation projects within the City of Minneapolis; and

Whereas, Phillip has served on the Heritage Preservation Commission since 1991; and

Whereas, Phillip has served as Chair of the Heritage Preservation Commission and actively served in a capacity far beyond the required call of duty; and

Whereas, Phillip has been actively involved with the designation and retention of significant buildings in Minneapolis, the respectful rehabilitation of historic buildings, and the conservation of historically significant neighborhoods; and

Whereas, Phillip has served as a member of the Saint Anthony Falls Heritage Board, an advisory board, that oversees and provides seed finding for capital improvements and educational programs in the Heritage Zone; and

Whereas, Phillip has served as master of ceremonies for the annual Minneapolis Preservation Awards; and

Whereas, Phillip is a member of "Team 007", an Ad Hoc group of Minneapolis preservation champions who meet monthly to increase awareness and promote a dialogue about preservation in Minneapolis; and

Whereas, Phillip is dedicated to improving the quality of life in the Twin Cities through urban-based projects, such as the Hennepin Theatre District, Pantages Theatre renovation, and station design for the Hiawatha Light Rail Transit system;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Heritage Preservation Commission, City Council, Mayor and Planning Director of the City of Minneapolis:

That we thank Phillip Koski for his faithful and constructive service in extending the progress of this city and in promoting the welfare of its people;

That we extend him our best wishes for good health and happiness, trusting that the friendships and understanding built in our mutual undertakings will be with us always.
