Supporting Information

Regulatory Services Traffic Control staff provide traffic management support at the University of Minnesota TCF Bank stadium. A contract has been drafted for the University to reimburse the City for these services. This is similar to the system that was in place when Traffic Control was in the Minneapolis Police Department. The estimated revenue for 2010 for these services is slightly over \$50,000, and it is included in the Regulatory Services revenue budget.
