

Hennepin County 2014-2015 Shelter Usage


- Median of 2,108 people in emergency shelter a night for last 12 months
 - 267 families (app. 1,148 people)
 - 899 single adults
 - 61 youth in youth specific shelters
- *Last unsheltered count = 207

Families in Hennepin County Shelters




Numbers represent families who stayed in shelter overnight on Tuesdays

Wilder Study-2012

- In Hennepin County shelters
 - 5% gay, lesbian, bisexual
 - 57% African American (36% of unsheltered), 24% white, 7% Hispanic, 6% multi-racial, 5% American Indian (28% of unsheltered, 1% Asian American
 - 78% GED or high-school degree
 - 20% grew up in Minneapolis
 - 80% have serious or chronic disability (mental illness, substance abuse disorder, etc. that limits daily living)

People Serving People

- Serves families vouchered through County
- 99 rooms
- Average of 117 families a night (40% of families)
- 614 S 3rd St (Downtown East)



St. Anne's Place

- Serves families vouchered through County
- Average of 15 families a night (5% of total)
- 2634 Russell Ave N (Jordan)



Francis Drake Hotel

- Overflow for families vouchered through County
- Average of 55 families a night (19% of families)
- 416 S 10th St (Downtown West)



Mary's Place

- Private family shelter
- Average of 92 families a night (31% of families)
- 401 N 7th St (North Loop)



Families Moving Forward

- Private family shelter
- Average of 6 families a night (2% of families)
- 1808 Emerson Ave N (Near North)



Salvation Army Harbor Lights

- Vouchered and secure waiting/overflow for single adults
- 364 beds
- Average of 476 people a night (54% of single adults), app. 120 women, 356 men
- 1010 Currie Ave (Downtown West)



Catholic Charities Higher Ground

- Vouchered and secure waiting for single men
- Average of 248 people a night (28% of single adults)
- 165 Glenwood Ave (North Loop)



Simpson Shelter

- Single adults
- Average of 67 people a night- 45 men, 22 women (8% of adults)
- 2740 1st Ave S (Whittier)



Our Saviour's

- Private single adult shelter
- Average of 40 people per night (34 men, 6 women), 5% of single adults
- 2315 Chicago Ave (Ventura Village)



St. Stephen's Shelter

- Private men's shelter
- Average of 45 men a night (5% of single adults)
- 2211 Clinton Ave (Whittier)



First Covenant (Salvation Army)

- Seasonal single adult shelter (November-April)
- Average of 37 people a night (29 men, 8 women), 4% of adults
- 810 S 7th St (Elliot Park)



River of Life (St. Stephen's)

- Seasonal men's shelter (November-April)
- Average of 50 men a night (6% of adults)
- 2200 Fremont Ave N (Jordan)



The Bridge for Youth

- Youth age 10-17
- Average of 10 youth a night (17% of youth)
- 1111 W 22nd St (East Isles)



Avenues for Youth- Minneapolis

- Youth age 16-20
- Average of 20 youth a night (34% of youth)
- 1708 Oak Park Ave N (Near North)



Avenues for Youth- Brooklyn Park

- Youth age 16-20
- Average of 11 youth a night (19% of youth)
- 7210 76th Ave N



Catholic Charities Hope Street

- Youth age 16-20
- Average of 26 youth a night (44% of youth)
- 1121 E 46th St (Northrup)
