SUBJECT: Agenda Item 7 – Update on CPP and NRP Funding

Action Requested:

This item is for informational purposes only. No action is requested.

On March 30th the City Council approved the revised guidelines for the Community Participation Program (CPP). The Council also approved up to \$5.7 million in CPP funding for the July 2012 – December 2013 funding cycle.

In addition to those actions, the Council approved an additional \$860,000 in funding for neighborhood organizations the lost funding in the December 2010 budget action and are not able to access at least 70 percent of their original (April 2004) Phase II NRP allocation. This action followed an earlier Council direction for staff to develop options to have the CPP allocation formula include additional funds for neighborhoods that lost dollars in the December 2010 budget action. The option to add \$860,000 in funding was supported by the NRP Policy Board at the March meeting. Attached is a table showing the allocations by neighborhoods.
