


Broadway St NE - Bicycle and Pedestrian Path

Stinson Blvd NE to Industrial Blvd NE

Project Background

Minneapolis Public Works is planning a bicycle and pedestrian project on Broadway St NE between Stinson Blvd NE to Industrial Blvd NE. This segment of Broadway St NE is currently lacking sidewalks and a safe place to bicycle. Public Works is proposing a near-term concept that would provide a space for people on foot and bicycle, while still accommodating existing motor vehicle traffic and freight access.

The project budget is \$110,000. Half of the project is being funded by a Hennepin County grant with the City of Minneapolis providing a 50% match. The project is being proposed for installation in the summer of 2015.



What is Being Proposed?

Broadway St NE between Stinson Blvd NE to Industrial Blvd NE currently has two westbound travel lanes and two eastbound lanes. The corridor is lacking sidewalks.


The proposed concept would:

- Remove 1 eastbound and 1 westbound travel lane
- Install a center turn lane
- Install a shared bicycle and pedestrian path on the south side of the street

What will the project look like?

The bicycle and pedestrian path would be at street level and separated by a painted buffer and white delineator posts.

A similar project was recently installed on 36th St W. →
