

BICYCLING TO THE AIRPORT
There are currently no bicycle-friendly routes to Terminals 1 or 2. The easiest way to bring your bicycle to the airport is via the Blue Line Light Rail. You can access Terminal 2 from 34th Avenue and Post Road, although the routes are long and indirect.

Bicycle parking is located at the Terminal 1 Transit Center and in the Terminal 2 parking ramp (follow signs). Most off-airport LRT stations also have bicycle parking.
