



To Interested Scrap Metal Processors and Used Vehicle Parts Dealers

Pursuant to requirements established by the State of Minnesota, effective July 14, 1994, bidders, at Dealer Auction, are required to hold either a valid Minnesota Scrap Metal Processor or Used Vehicle Parts License in order to participate in **Dealer Auctions** at the City of Minneapolis impound Lot.

All such bidders must present their state-issued license and sign a revised affidavit prior to bidding. All such licenses will be verified by this office.

Businesses located in the City of Minneapolis must additionally possess and maintain a valid Minneapolis Used Motor Vehicle Parts Dealer License.

No other licensee of any sort or kind will be permitted to bid.

The City specifically reserves the right to disqualify and/or exclude any dealer who abuses the purchase process relating to junk/scrap vehicles.
